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About the 2-D Design Portfolio

In the 2-D Design Portfolio, you should demonstrate your understanding of design principles as applied to a two-dimensional surface. The principles of design (unity/variety, balance, emphasis, contrast, rhythm, repetition, proportion/scale and figure/ground relationship) can be articulated through the visual elements (line, shape, color, value, texture, space). Any 2-D process or medium may be submitted, including, but not limited to, graphic design, digital imaging, photography, collage, fabric design, weaving, illustration, painting, printmaking, etc. Videotapes, three-dimensional works, and photocopies of your work in other media may not be submitted.

Only click **Submit Portfolio** when you have finished uploading and arranging images for Sections II and III and are ready to formally submit to your teacher. If you are not ready to submit and want to work on your portfolio later, you can simply save and exit.

Your home page displays instructions and general information about your portfolio.

Uploading Images: As soon as you have your first digital images available, you can begin uploading them. You will be able to rearrange the images as you work on the portfolio sections. Below is a sample portfolio work area for Section II: Concentration, showing numbered boxes for your images:

When working on the Concentration section, you can enter or view your commentary by clicking the **Commentary** tab.

Use these buttons to select whether you want to view images only, or the images with their labels.

To upload an image, begin by clicking the **Browse** button. This will allow you to browse your computer for the image file you want and then upload it.

When you select the **Images & Labels** view, these boxes will allow you to label your image with the dimensions of the artwork and the medium used to create it.

To delete an image, click the red **x** above it.

After uploading a file, you'll see a thumbnail image in the box. You can click the thumbnail to display the full-sized image.

You can rearrange your images by changing the numbers above them and then clicking **Save All Changes**.

Note: The work areas for Section III: Breadth and for Section I: Quality of a 3-D Design portfolio will look similar to this but will not include the **Commentary** button.
