Concentration Statement

- My concentration idea focuses on surfaces and how they usually lack depth, but can become more unique when their original texture is transformed into something different, as it gives more depth to the surface and tells more a story.
- Images 1, 2, 3 and 4 show how time has changed the normal surface of an object, and how the surfaces reflect the wear and tear they've experienced over time (such as how in image 1 people walking on the stairs constantly have changed it's surface and how the locker in image 2 has become old and worn because of constant use). Photos 5, 6, 7 and 8 show how ordinary surfaces when juxtaposed with contrasting surfaces of another object emphasize the texture of both surfaces (how in image 5, the plain window and the pattern of the snail contrast and emphasize each other and how in image 7, the surface of the bush seems to envelop the person in it). Images 9 and 10 show how surfaces can reflect objects and become more unique in doing so. And images 11 and 12 are a combination of how juxtaposing surfaces and how surfaces transform over time give the surface more depth and a story to tell.
