Part 2 Editing

1. Edit your image using the two Duotone styles below:

• Type 1 Duotone

- > open image in Photoshop > image > adjustments > black and white (note: you can use the preset default or select one of the other options)
- > create a new layer > layer > new > layer or click new layer icon >



- > fill new layer with a color > edit > fill > color > choose a warm or cool color*
- > change new layer Mode to Multiply (adjust opacity if you want)
- > save as a PSD: Your Name_ type 1
- * warm colors are yellows, oranges and reds; cool colors are greens, blues and purples.

· Type 2 Duotone

- > open image in Photoshop > image > mode > grayscale > discard
- > image > mode > duotone > type > duotone >
- > double click the Ink 2 color box, choose a color and type in color's name
- > adjust colors using the curve graph if you want
- > save as a PSD: Your Name_ type 2
