

AP – How to turn in your summer assignment:

Part 1: Breadth and Concentration Images - turn into flickr

Once you are logged into flickr, upload all your photos you shot over the summer.

Create two albums and title them:

Breadth – Summer 2018

Concentration – Summer 2018

Place your 30 images of each into their respective albums

Part 2: Your Thoughts and Inspiration - turn into Google Classroom

Assignment name: “My Thoughts and Inspiration – Summer 2018”

All in once Google Doc or Word Doc:

- Type your concentration explanation
- Copy and paste the 5 images of the photographer you have chosen into the document
- Type your summary of the photographer and include your works cited in MLA format (at least two sources).
- Copy and paste your five photos you took to emulate your chosen photographer into the document

Part 3: Museum/Gallery Visit - turn into Google Classroom

Assignment name: “Museum/Gallery Visit – Summer 2018”

In a Word Doc or Google Doc, include this:

- A selfie of you at the venue
- Give a full page explanation of your visit (this full page only includes text – not the images). Include some of the names of the artists you saw. Include in your document sample images from these artists. You may not be able to photograph the pieces you see at the venue, so you can look up images online and include them in your report. You should reflect on the impact the images have made on you and some artistically relevant information on the display you saw. What was your favorite piece(s) you saw at the exhibit? Why?
