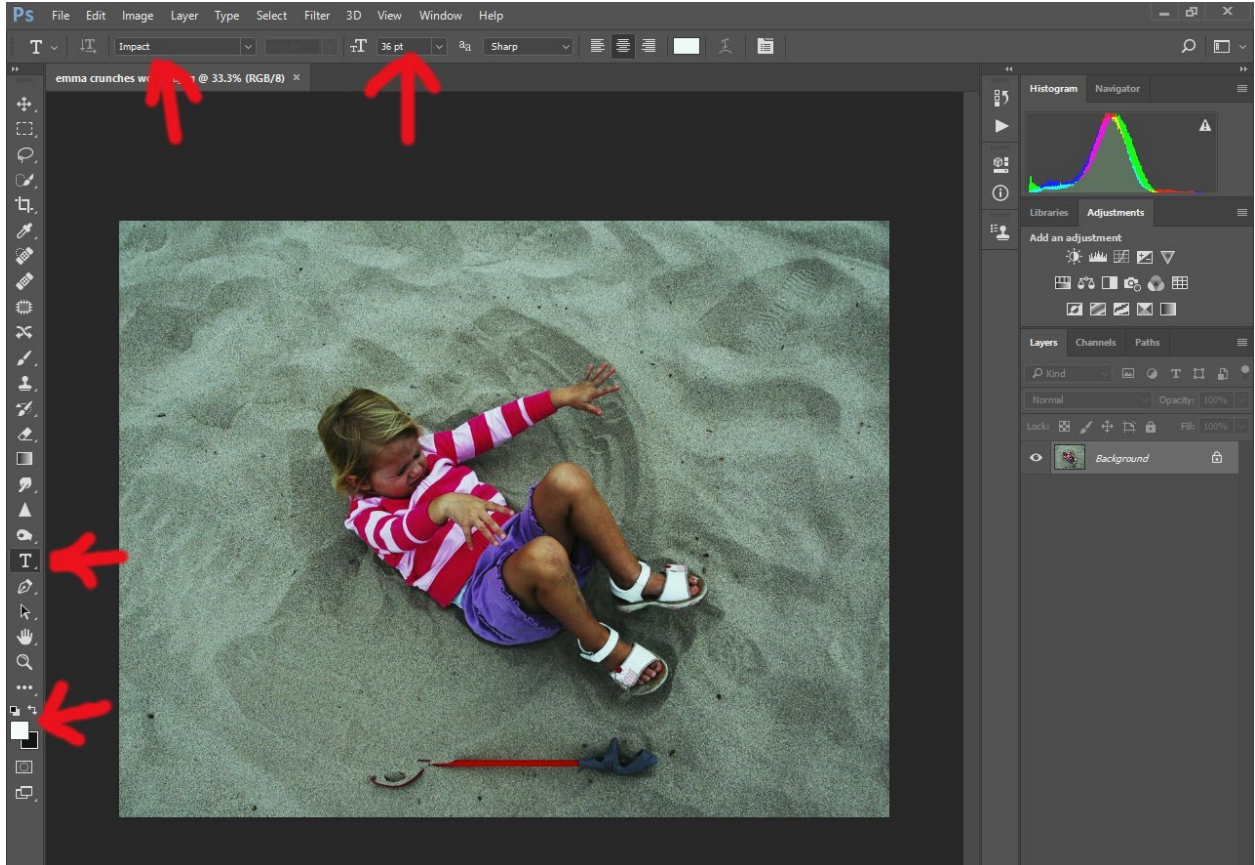
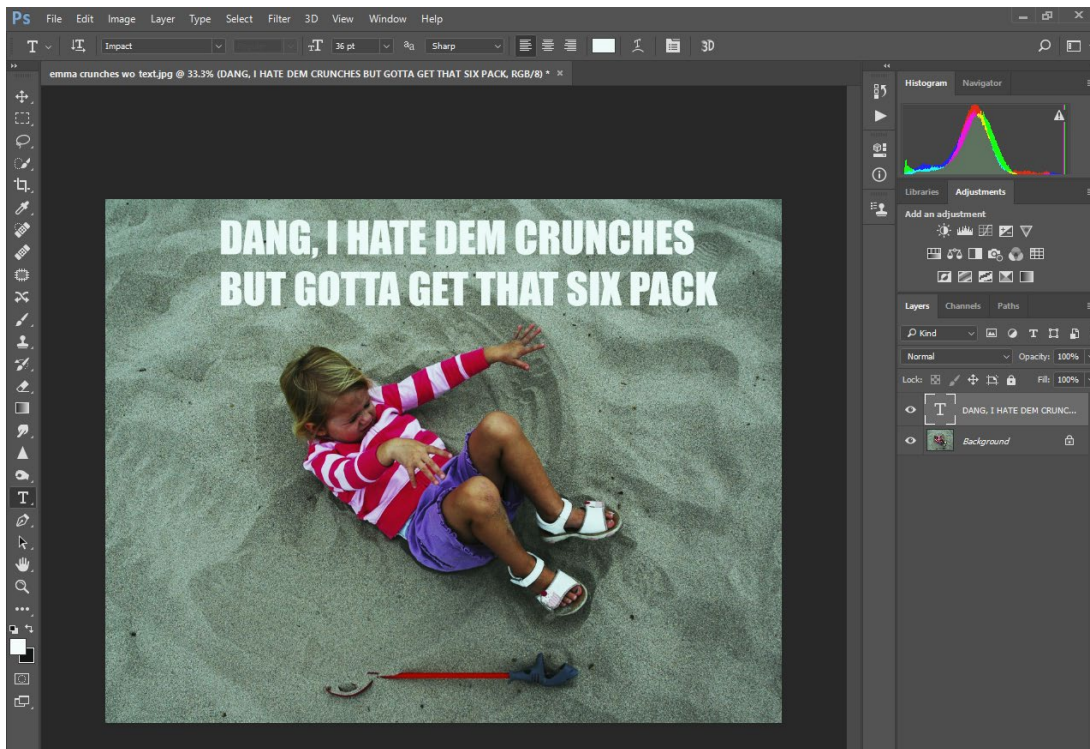


Meme Tutorial

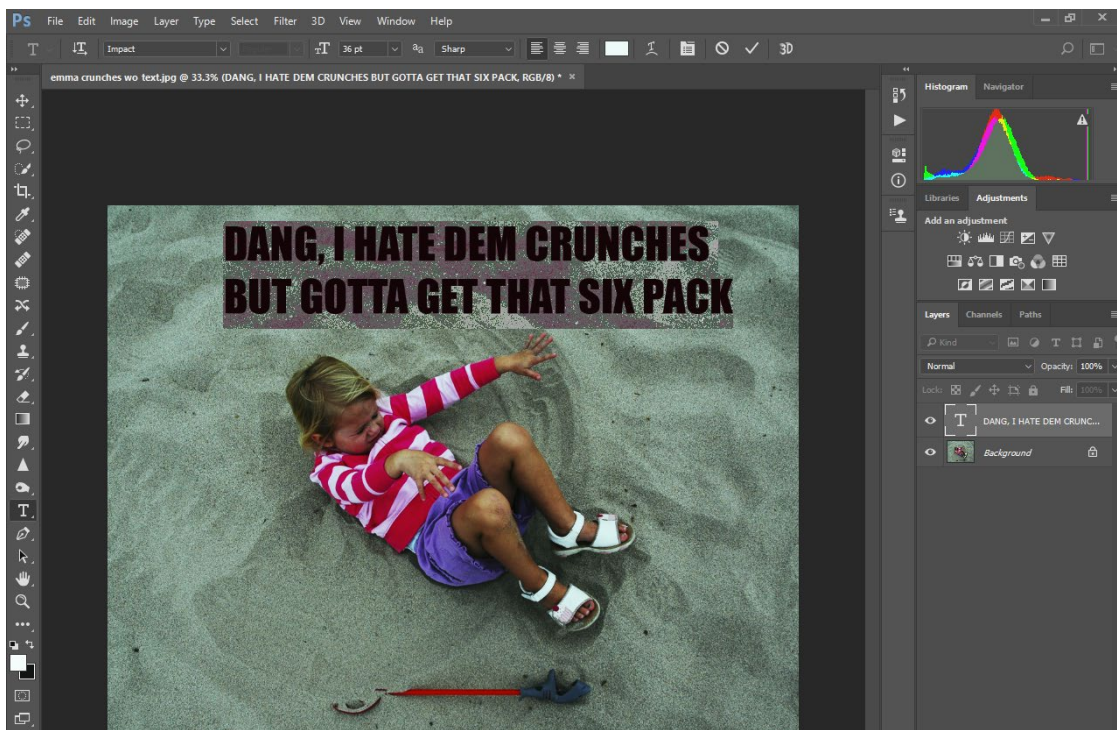
1. Once you have opened your image, you will need to get some settings and tools set up.
 - A. Be sure the foreground color is white (bottom arrow below).
 - B. Click on the text tool (the T on the tool bar)
 - C. Click on the text font drop down menu and select "Impact"
 - D. The font size is variable depending on the image's resolution size. If is a typical DSLR jpeg, the font size might need to be around 300 or so. It can always be changed.



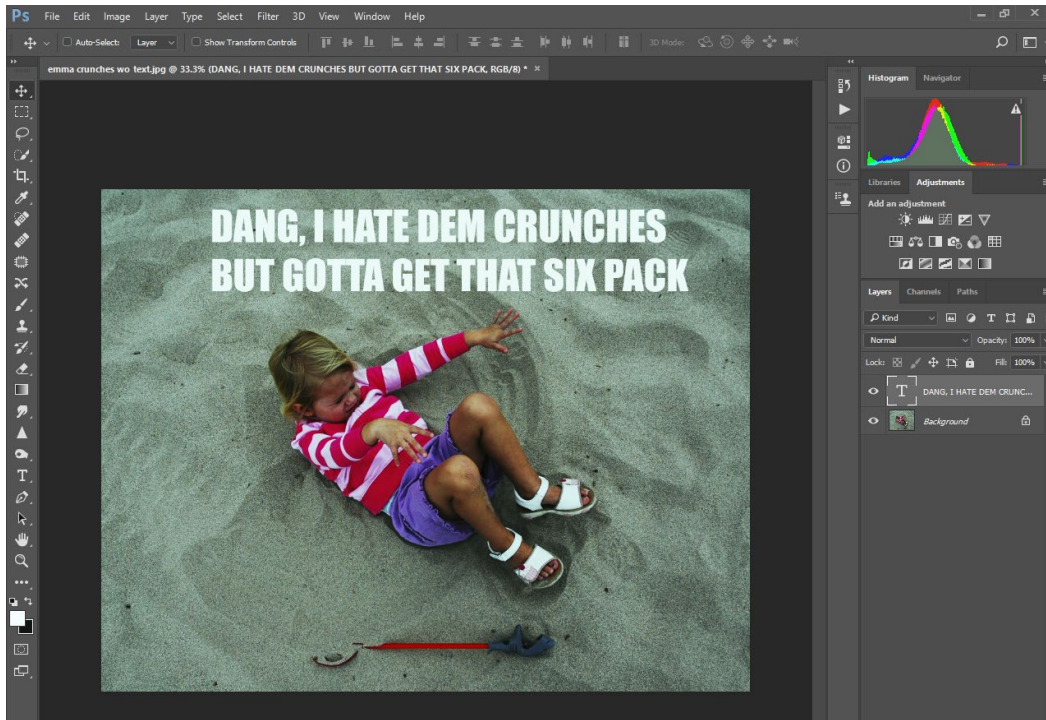
- Left click in the image in the area you would like the text to appear and start typing the words.



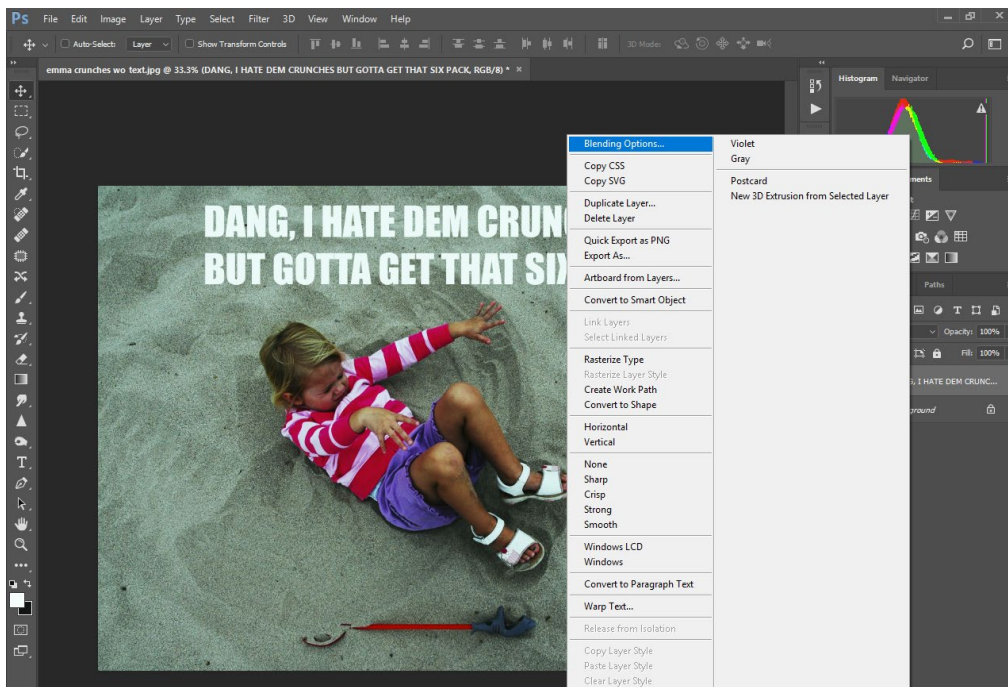
- If you would like to change the font size, make sure the text tool is active and left click on the text and hold and select the entire text.



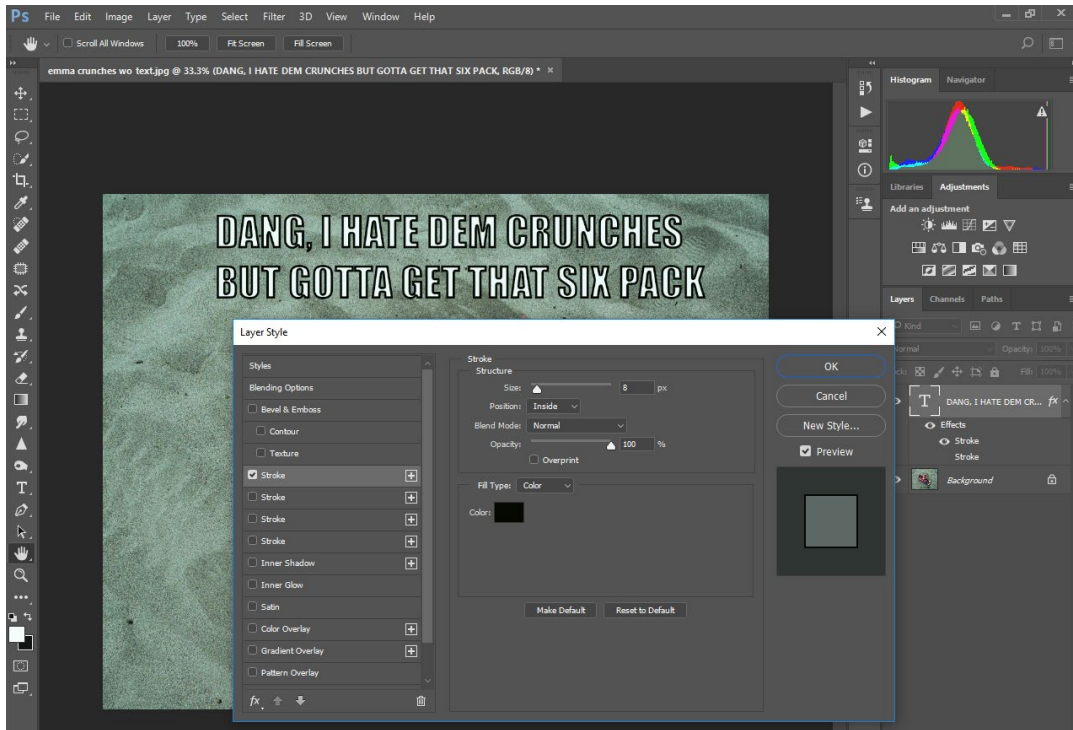
- You can move the text box around using the move tool (top tool on toolbar – looks like a cross with arrows)



- Now right click on the text layer and go to Blending Options.



- Click on the plus sign to the right of Stroke. Then adjust the size slider to the outline size you want. This number is usually between 5-9 depending on how thick you want the black outline to be.



- And this is the final product:
