You will edit two photos for each shoot.

LINE – TEXTURE – SHAPE – PORTRAIT – MOTION FREEZE – MOTION PAN – MOTION BLUR

What type of editing should you be doing?

ONLY EDIT WHAT IS NECESSARY – DO NOT OVER-EDIT YOUR IMAGES!!!

Do these as needed:

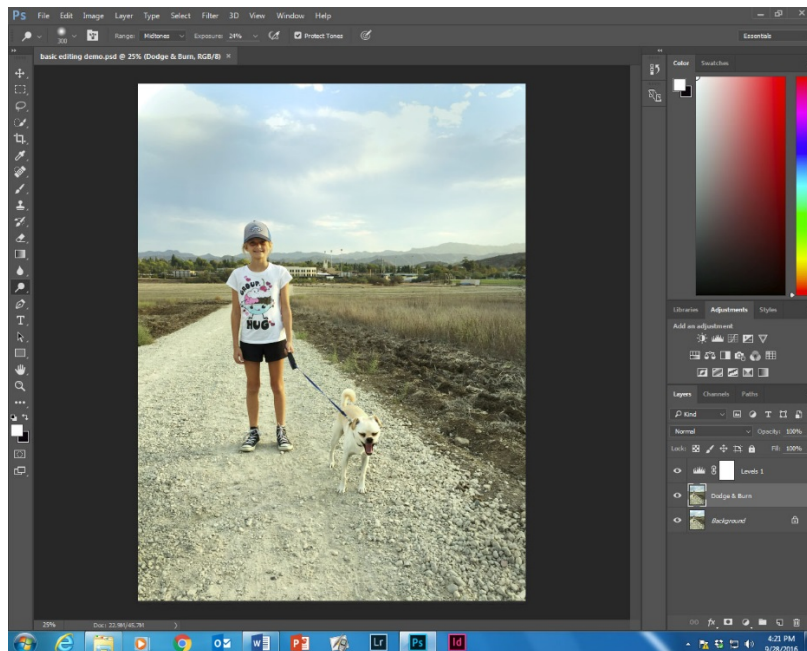
STRAIGHTEN AND CROP

ADJUST LEVELS

DODGE AND BURN

BLACK & WHITE (if you prefer image that way)

YOU MAY USE OTHER ADJUSTMENT LAYERS IF YOU WOULD LIKE! The more you try them out the more you will learn and the more options you will have as a photo editor.



Turn in image before editing and the final edited image. Images must be submitted to Google Photos and Classroom.

If you forget how to use a tool, JUST ASK!!! Ask a fellow student or ask me. That is what I am here for. No stupid questions with me – you know that because I say it all the time...right?

The first time I used these tools, I had to be shown a few times before I got it.

I recommend you save your Photoshop Document File (PSD) somewhere in your storage system (on the Student G drive, on a flash drive, your SD card, on your computer desktop or documents if you have room). I would not recommend Google Drive to save PSDs.
