You can shoot a photo of something ugly (like a traffic jam) in good light and the photo turns out beautifully.




Beautiful subject, harsh light

"GOOD" Light



- When sunny outside, shoot in *Open Shade*
- Overcast days are the best light conditions for most photography
- Shoot 10 minutes before sunrise or 10 minutes after sunset

What is Open Shade?




What does open shade or a cloudy day do?




