
## <u>iPhone Camera Settings for Compatibility</u>


Most iPhones and other apple devices shoot what is called a HEIC file type for their photos. This file type does not always work so well with other digital platforms, including Photoshop and Photopea.

Here is what you do to make it more compatible:


Go to the Settings Button on your Home Screen and click on it




Go to the Camera App

Choose Most Compatible. This will have the camera shoot in JPEG format



You are welcome to just shoot for this class on Most Compatible and then move it to High Efficiency for other images. HEIC files are supposed to convert to JPEGs once uploaded to an email or Google Photos, but that is not always the case.
