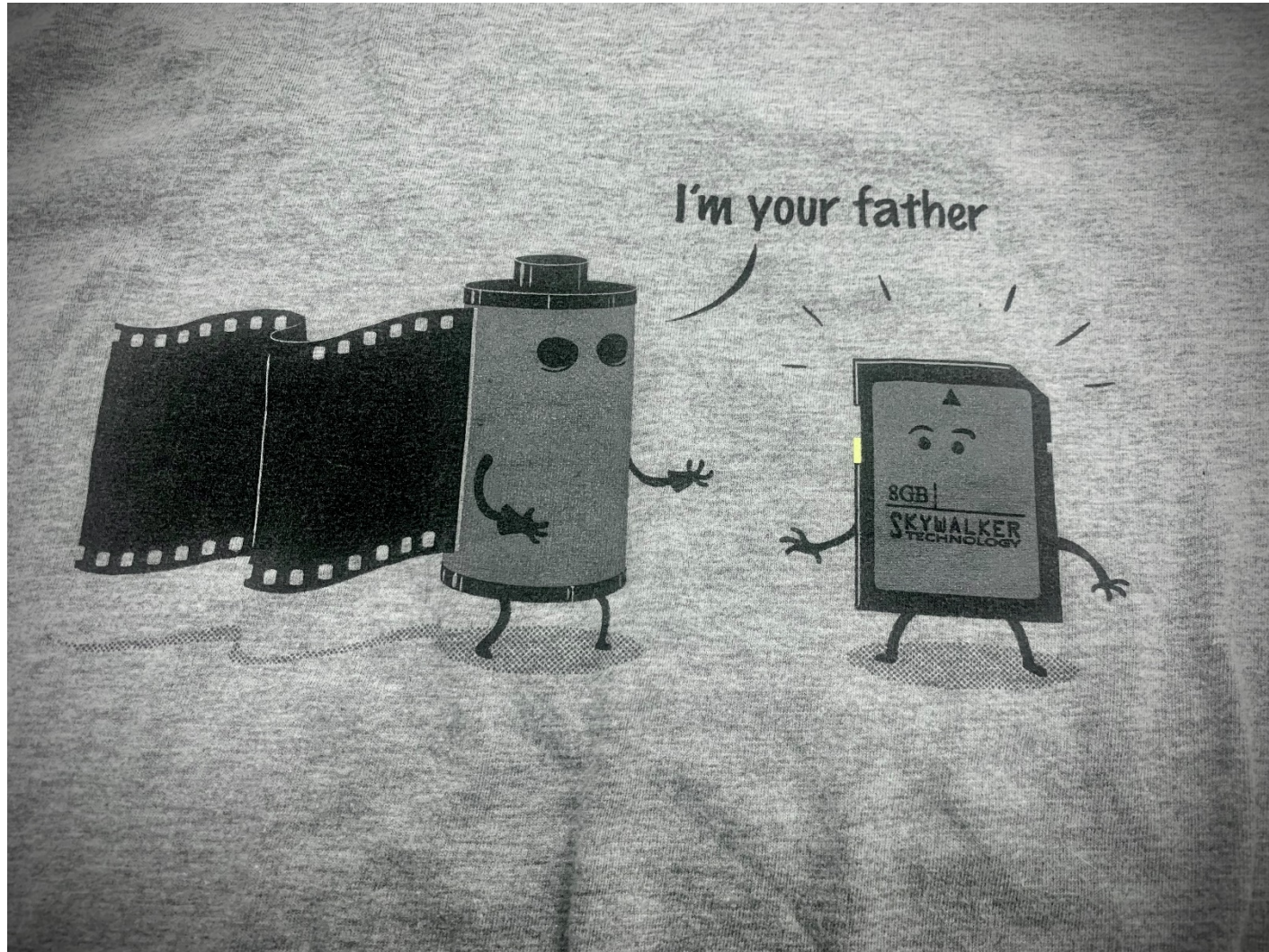


Digital/Film Shoot #1 – Lines in Pattern

Shoot outside only
(especially film)

Shoot indoors at this point may underexpose

Photographic Composition Guidelines

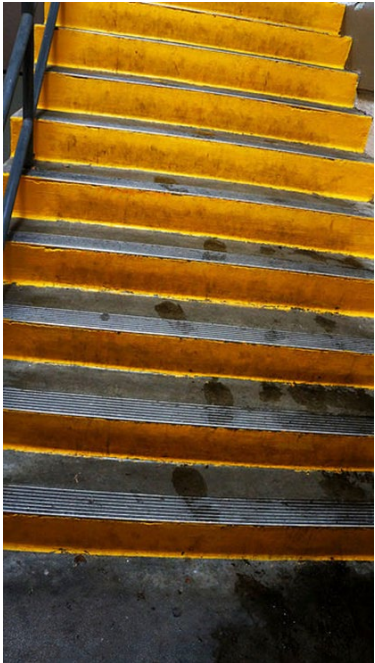
- **Simplicity**

- **Avoid Mergers**



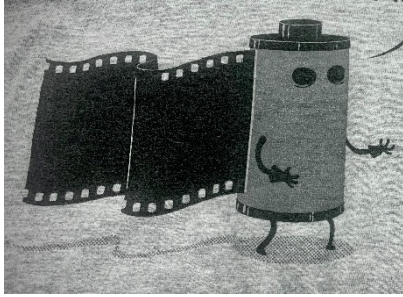

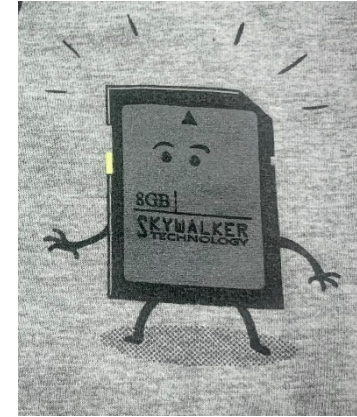


How many images to shoot



Film

- shoot all 24 exposures on film
- **at least 12 exposures must be of lines**
- can shoot 12 exposures of other topics
- Entire roll of film must be finished by end of class



Digital

- Shoot many images
- **You will turn in your best 25 of line**
- You may shoot other topics for fun
- This photo shoot can be continued or added to later



How to view, scan, and delete digital images



Carry your camera safely



Put camera dial to
Off or L (lock)



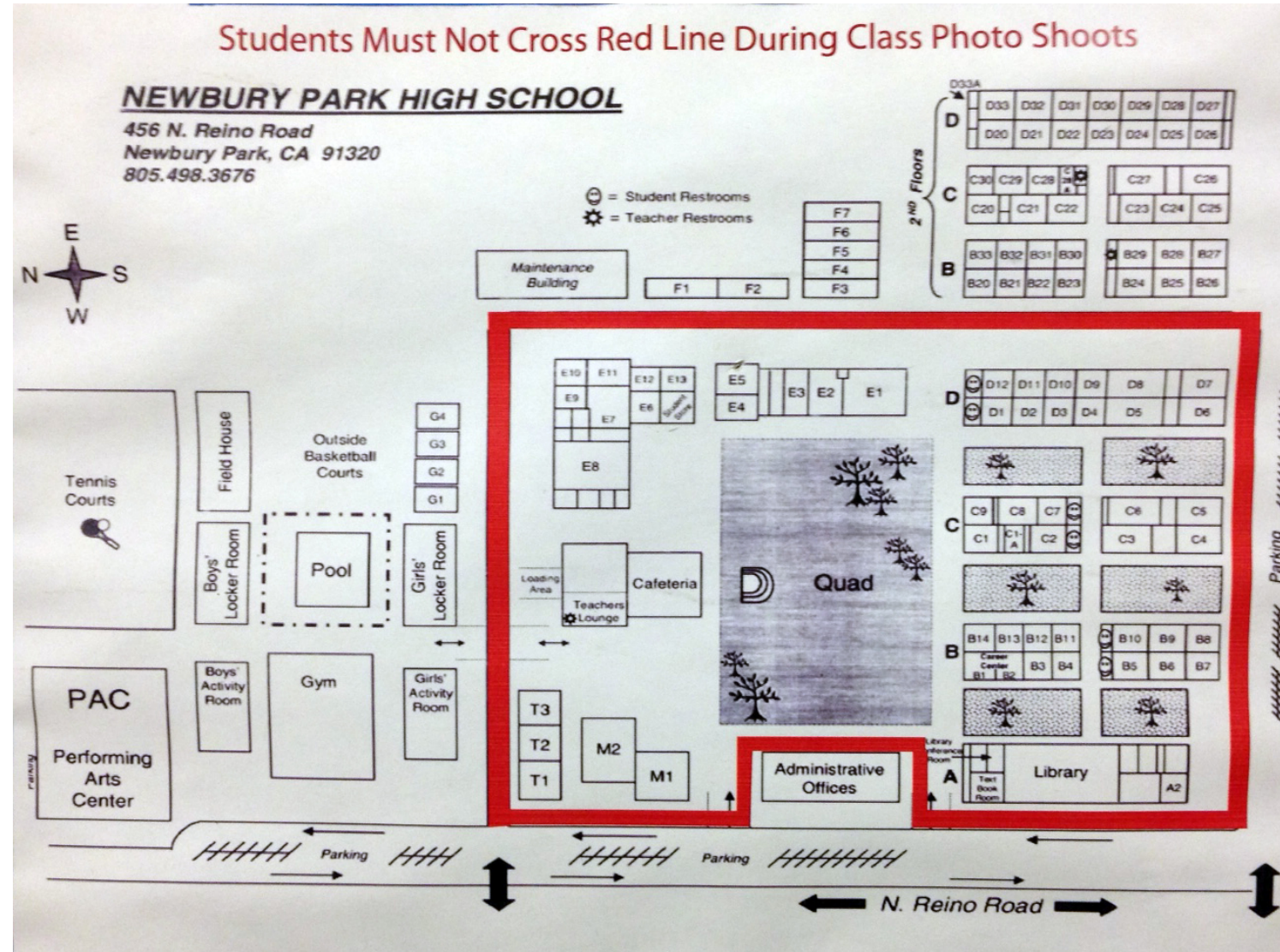


Switch to Off

Reminders

- **Keep voices low**
