Photography Two Syllabus Mr. Lindroth

Photography Two focuses a great deal on advanced production and post-production techniques. Students are given a great deal of choice in how they pursue their work.

Here are the Modules in this class:

Finishing out Motion Photos Edited digital and printed motion photos are due in the first week of this class.	Required Darkroom Projects Students will all do these projects: Sandwiched Negatives, Open Topic Film Shoot (one contact sheet and two prints), and Sepia Toning
Intermediate Photoshop Projects Students demonstrate competence with the healing tools, blending modes, masks, and transform tool in Photoshop.	Advanced Projects Students are given a menu of advanced techniques used in film and darkroom, Photoshop, and image capture. Students are required to turn in a certain number of advanced technique projects.
Free Choice Projects Students choose their own topics and/or techniques and turn in a certain number of images based on the challenge of the choice they have made. Guidelines are on the website.	Advanced Camera Tools and Functions Students will demonstrate competence in using ISO, White Balance, Exposure Control, and Depth of Field control.
Quizzes and Test on Camera Tools and Functions Students will demonstrate knowledge of camera tools and functions by taking quizzes using Kahoot and Canvas and eventually a multiple choice test.	Concentration Students will compile several images into a Google Slides or Power Point that are interconnected by a theme and/or technique. Students will also include two famous photographers in the slides that pursue similar work.
Final Printed Portfolio Students will dry mount their best 6-10 best images (at 3 must be darkroom and 3 must be digital). Students purchase mount boards from student store.	Photographic Philosophizing Students engage in photography by writing about personal, historic, and professional works.

Costs for class:
