For High School Students in Articulated Classes


INSTRUCTIONS (READ THIS CAREFULLY!)

All students who wish to receive college credit from Moorpark College must apply to the college and receive a college student ID number. Each college student ID number starts with "900" and for this reason it is commonly referred to as a "900 Number". 
- 1. Use the screen images and accompanying directions to complete the application.







6. Enter your name. If you have a suffix (such as "Jr."), or a preferred name, you may selection the option to enter it.






8. Enter your email address twice, then enter your phone number. You are not required to authorize text messages, and you are not required enter a Second Telephone Number.




9. Enter your address (where you live or where you get mail.) <u>Do not</u> check the boxes unless they apply to you! Click "Continue."




10. Create a Username for your application account, and a Password. Enter the password twice. Then create 4-digit Security PIN and enter it twice.





17. Check the box next to "My mailing address is the same as the Permanent Address in my OpenCCC Account above" to avoid having to enter your address again.






19. Select "I attended high school." Under "State," select California. Below that, type the name of your high school and select it when it appears.



20. Starting with your last completed grade level, select the options from the drop down menus that apply to you, including your estimated GPA, and your last completed English and math courses.




21. Under College Education, select "No degree." Under Colleges/Universities Attended, select "None." DO NOT SELECT ANY OTHER OPTIONS.




