AP-IB Photo Scavenger Hunt

Rules:

- 1. See Canvas for Deadline.
- 2. All images must be shot on campus
- 3. All images must be new ones shot for this specific shoot. You cannot re-use old images here (unless they are composited in with a new image).
- 4. You must work as a team (if someone really wants to fly solo ok)
- 5. Images must be edited for quality
- 6. Images can have some post-production manipulations applied to them
- 7. You may bring props from home for your photos
- 8. No references to drugs, alcohol, or smoking
- 9. No sexual content
- 10. Do not interrupt classes (if you want to shoot a picture with a teacher, or use a student in a class, consult with the teacher beforehand)
- 11. No climbing on buildings or jumping off high heights or doing anything dangerous to yourself, others, or property.

How you will be judged:

Creativity/Impact Quality Composition

Here is the list of what you need to photograph – Number 30 is required (not required to enter as your competition pieces):

- 1. a photo displaying madness
- 2. a photo with some/all of your members of your group and a black panther (the NPHS kind, not the civil rights group)
- 3. a photo of at least two "opposite" textures
- 4. a photo that shows "spastic" or "spaz"
- 5. a photo displaying ecstatic joy
- 6. a photo showing an interesting background merger with the central subject
- 7. a photo demonstrating gluttony
- 8. an interesting use of hands and lockers
- 9. a photo with an interesting use of reflection or refraction
- 10. a photo that makes interesting use of a staircase(s)
- 11. a photo with a toy or stuffed animal(s) or toy(s) in strange circumstance
- 12. an object in a place you normally would not find that object
- 13. a silhouette of someone or something
- 14. a photo that truly reveals the personality of that person
- 15. an interesting use of cell phone(s)
- 16. A photo that conveys a great feeling of tension
- 17. A photo that includes a seagull or other bird on campus
- 18. A photo that expresses ecstatic freedom
- 19. A photo that expresses oppressive confinement
- 20. A photo that interestingly shows a door knob or door handle
- 21. A creepy photo
- 22. A photo of all or most of your group with a black panther (school mascot not the Black Panther party)
- 23. An interesting photo with a recycle bin in it
- 24. A photo that makes a very creative use of light
- 25. Create a meme with an image shot on campus
- 26. A photo with a creative composition using a tree (you cannot climb up a tree for this)
- 27. A photo with a creative composition using books
- 28. A photo that shows animosity/conflict between the film and digital photo worlds of photography
- 29. A photo that shows the harmony between the film and digital photo worlds
- 30. A photo using one or more of the gold flamingos (this one is required)

You must complete 15. You will select your best 3-5 for competition. On each image, please put a text layer describing the topic. For example: "Scary" or "Ecstatic Joy".

Choose one person from you group to upload the images to Canvas. Put all 15 in an album labeled "scavenger hunt." Your top 3-5 will be placed on a flash drive I will provide. Please put these images in a folder labeled with all names in the group).
